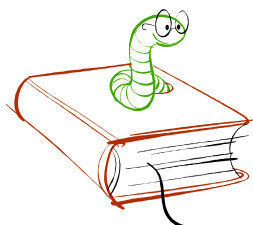
BOOK FAIR
